(b) Please note that the Fund distribution could be reviewed in the subsequent quarters based on the following two (2) parameters:-

1. There are five (5) wards where elections were postponed namely—

- Kyome/ Thaana Ward in Mwingi West constituency, Kitui County;
- Oloimasani Ward in Emurua Dikirr constituency, Narok County;
- Mumias North Ward in Mumias West constituency, Kakamega County;
- South Gem Ward in Gem constituency, Siaya County; and
- Utawala Ward in Embakasi East constituency, Nairobi County.

The elections of the above wards once concluded will have an effect on the allocations and resultant change will be effected in the subsequent quarter's disbursements.
