



## COMMUNIQUE TO POLITICAL PARTIES ON THE SALIENT TIMELINES FOR THE 27<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2025 BY-ELECTIONS

- 1. The Office of the Registrar of Political Parties (ORPP) is an independent state office established under Section 33 of Political Parties Act

  Cap. 7D with the broad mandate to register and regulate political parties as well administer the Political Parties Fund.
- 2. Pursuant to Article 88(4) of the Constitution, the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC) issued notices in the Gazette on 8th August 2025 and 11th August 2025 vide Vol. CXXVII—No. 169 Gazette Notice No. 11160 and Vol. CXXVII—No. 170 Gazette Notice No. 11163 for by-elections to be held on Thursday 27th November, 2025.
- 3. Flowing from the above and in line with Part IVA of the Political Parties Act Cap. 7D on party nominations, the attention of political parties is drawn to the following salient timelines: -
